- * **For acceptance to show, all entry forms must be filled out completely and signed by the exhibitor.**
- * **No telephone entries will be accepted.**
- * **Entry fees for animals not shown will not be refunded.**
- * **The following drop passes will be given for light horse classes:**
 - 1 or 2 horses - 1 drop pass**
 - 3 horses or more - 2 drop passes**

Rules and Regulations

1. Each exhibitor is subject to and should be familiar with the By-laws of the Metcalfe Agricultural Society.
2. Exhibitors showing livestock at the Metcalfe Agricultural Society Fall Fair must show proof of liability insurance of minimum one million dollars on entry form, including the name of owner or company, amount of insurance and expiry date.
3. Judging to commence at 12:00 noon sharp on Saturday. Classes to be judged in order in which they appear in the prize list. **Please notify the announcer should a hold on the gate be required.**
4. All entries close **Tuesday, September 11, 2007.**
5. Joint ownership permitted in all Light Horse Classes.
6. Stake Classes - to be eligible for entry in a Stake Class at this show, the animals must have been entered, shown and judged in at least one other class in the respective Division. Certain Stake Classes have specific requirements as to what classes qualify the animal for the Stake. See class descriptions for specifics.

7. Stallions are not eligible in any children's class.
8. Membership fee of \$8.00, **unless retained from last year's prize money**, must accompany entry forms.
9. All exhibitors and attendants must be neatly and appropriately attired upon entering the ring.
10. Horses/ponies shown in their respective division are not eligible for any other division unless otherwise stated.

Special Notice - Any person who shall attempt to interfere with the judges while in the discharge of their duties, who shall at any time, on the premises of the Society use any contemptuous or abusive language to any judge in consequence of any award made by him, shall forfeit his right to any premium to which they might otherwise be entitled, and may be excluded from exhibiting for one year thereafter. Judges are requested to immediately report any breach of this rule.
