Entries in all cattle classes must be made on or before **Tuesday, September 11, 2007**. The following regulations concerning the health of cattle to be shown at the Metcalfe Fair have been accepted and approved by the Metcalfe Fair Board. Any cattle other than those from a herd under quarantine are eligible to enter a show without restriction. A Livestock Superintendent will be present at all times to instruct exhibitors. All cattle must be unloaded and reloaded from the East End of all barns.

The following drop passes will be given for the Beef Classes: 1-5 animals, 1 pass; 6 animals or more, 2 passes.

RULES

1. All general rules which are applicable will apply.
2. All entry forms must be in by **Tuesday, Sept. 11, 2007**, to the Metcalfe Agricultural Society, P.O. Box 29, Metcalfe, Ontario, K0A 2P0. **LATE ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER THAT TIME WILL BE SUBJECT TO AN ADDITIONAL \$5.00 PER ANIMAL.**
3. A membership fee of \$8.⁰⁰ **MUST** accompany all entry forms, unless retained from last year's prize money.
4. An administration fee of 20% will be deducted from the prize money.
5. There is no restriction on multiple exhibits in any classes, excluding the Breeders Herd.
6. All cattle must be registered and exhibitor must produce registration papers.
7. Judging of breeding classes to commence at 12 Noon, Sunday, September 30, 2007.
8. Proof of liability insurance must be shown on the entry form.

9. Any early arrivals on Saturday will not be allowed to tie in the Agri-View Show Barn until after the steers and lambs have been removed from the auction Saturday night. No exceptions, as this is for everyone's safety.

THE FOLLOWING 9 SECTIONS WILL BE OFFERED IN EACH CLASS.

1. Bull-calf, born on or after Jan. 1, 2007. Minimum of three months of age on day of judging and that they may also be part of the breeder's herd.
2. Bull-yearling, born Jan. 1, 2006 to Dec. 31, 2006.
3. Bull-born Jan. 1, 2005 to Dec. 31, 2005.
4. Female-calf, born on or after Jan. 1, 2007. Minimum of three months of age on day of judging and that they may also be part of the breeder's herd.
5. Female-heifer, born March 1, 2006, to Dec. 31, 2006.
6. Female-heifer, born Jan. 1, 2006, to Feb. 28, 2006.
7. Female-born Jan. 1, 2005, to Dec. 31, 2005, with her own 2007 natural, purebred, tattooed, calf at foot. Female and calf shall be shown as a unit except that the calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in section 1 or 4 or section 9 (Breeder's Herd).
8. Female-born prior to Jan. 1, 2005, with her own 2007 natural purebred, tattooed, calf at foot. Female and calf shall be shown as a unit except that the calf is eligible to be shown as single animal in Section 1 or 4 or section 9 (Breeder's Herd).
9. Breeder's Herd-a group of 4 animals bred by the exhibitor, both sexes represented, must be exhibited in previous classes. At least one animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor.

Special Notice - The requirements are three exhibitors and 24 animals per breed, otherwise only 50% prize money will be paid. We reserve the right to cancel the show if there are insufficient exhibitors and animals.
