Any exhibitor that exhibits any quilt and any other item whose design may be subject to copyright, must read and adhere to the following:

An exhibitor may create an item from a design pattern that he/she has purchased for his/her personal use/enjoyment. An exhibitor cannot display his/her item using the purchased design pattern in a public facility or exhibition without the permission of the owner of the design pattern. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to obtain permission from the designer.

The exhibitor will properly credit the design to the owner. This information should be indicated on the form that will be provided when entries are submitted at the Metcalfe Fair office.

Prize money is a matter of negotiation between the design owner and the exhibitor. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to negotiate this at the time the exhibitor is seeking the designer's permission for use of the said design.
