

2010 4-H HORSE REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

GENERAL INFORMATION

The show will be held on Sunday October 3, 2010 in Metcalfe, Ontario, during the Metcalfe Fair. Enter fair at last entrance - Gate # 4. Trailer parking on right, show will be taking place in light ring on left side of laneway. Stalls will be available in the heavy barn.

Showtime is **11:00 am**.

The judge this year will be Dale Vance.

Registrations must be in by September 15, 2010; see enclosed entry form. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.** You must also register on the day of the show no later than 10:00 pm, or you will not be allowed to show.

Again, this year we are asking each club to bring a prize for each member entered which will be given out during showmanship classes. It is up to your discretion, or the leader what you wish to donate. Please have these prizes at the registration table no later than 10:00 pm.

The classes are as follows (see entry form):

1. Showmanship (**The age divisions are as of Jan 1, 2010**)

***Please note changes to age divisions.**

- senior (age18-21)
- intermediate (age15-17)
- junior (age12-14)
- novice (10-11)

2. Grand Champion/ Reserve Champion halter

3. Walk/Jog/Trot (see entry form, only allowed in this class)

4. Horsemanship, class will be divided depending on numbers. This will be a pattern class then working off the rail.

a) English or b) Western

a) novice/junior b) intermediate/senior

5. Command novice/junior

6. Command intermediate/senior

Patterns for all these classes will be posted at least a half an hour before show time.

***** ****Tie Up Competition*******

This year there will be a tie up competition, taking place in the heavy horse barn. This will be a great opportunity for all members of your club to come out to the Regional Show. Ribbons for 1st & 2nd place club plus plaque will be given for best Tie Up at the end of the day.

It is **STRONGLY** recommended that all clubs use the heavy barn for stabling their horses. It makes it much easier to communicate, and keep track of the all groups.

GENERAL RULES

- Only participating 4-H members will be allowed to work on preparing the 4-H animal for the show.

- Proof of insurance must be presented at time of registration.
- Each club per county is allowed **three** per division.
- NOTE: **ALL MEMBERS MUST WEAR HELMET FOR RIDING CLASSES**, (Ontario Bill 12)
- NOTE for riding classes you may wear jackets/ vest etc. Dress code is for the showmanship classes.
